Altona	Parkside Junior High School (155 5th Street NW, Altona)	October 16 2020 A confirmed case of COVID-19 was present in the school on Oct. 16 then the individual may have been infectious. The school will remain open to all other students and staff, who can continue to attend school in person.

- Public Skate will be cancelled for the next few weeks.
- When public skate resumes, we will have extra procedures in place to ensure the safety of our community.
 - St Adolphle Residence only
 - Must sign up prior to the allotted time.
- Darcy is looking into having a pre-screening protocol for all people entering the building somewhat like The Rink has in place.
- Amber and Montana will work on a map which shows the new “traffic flow” of the arena. It will show where to enter the building and where to exit.
- Once the new Traffic Flow Map is completed
 - Darren will upload to Eastman along with the newest Covid protocols
 - Montana will upload to our community website
 - Jamie and Darcy will ensure its uploaded to our site on Amelia
- New Covid protocol states we are allowed 25% of our capacity in our building.
 - 364 in the arena = 91 people
 - 109 in the lobby = 27 people

- 375 in the hall = 93 people
- Skaters are allowed only one other person in the building with them
- The CEO of the RM of Ritchot, Thomas Thompson, will help us set up payroll for our 3 new Covid support staff. We received a grant- Return to Work Wage Subsidy Program- where 50% of their wage will be covered by the provincial government up to \$5000.
 - Jamie will create a schedule for the paid employees.
 - Lisa will schedule the volunteers from the minor hockey pool of volunteers.
- Effective November 1st, all ice times will increase by \$10 an hour to cover the expense of the covid support staff with the exception of our minor hockey program as they are supplying volunteers to cover their extra Covid expense.
- Jay Stade and Mike Plesiuk will be pricing out systems and cameras so we will be able to virtually broadcast our games.
 - Currently, they found a system for \$2500.
